

## THE 9<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH SPEECH CONTEST FOR RAJABHAT AND ASEAN UNIVERSITIES

#### 20th September 2023

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

Over a decade, ASEAN has been increasingly recognized by peoples in Southeast Asian nations as a large number of such public and private organizations have been deliberately preparing their members, with an emphasis on raising their awareness in regard to effects of becoming one of the founding members of the ASEAN Community. Apart from a particular focus on ASEAN knowledge, the English abilities of citizens in each ASEAN country are considered as equally crucial since this language has been used widely as an international means for global communication.

In as much as English is reasonably essential and apparently required as concisely mentioned, not only do ASEAN universities beneficially offer English courses to students, but they also provide them with extracurricular activities, especially exchange events and competitions among educational institutions, to enhance their English proficiency and personal interactions. For this reason, Thepsatri Rajabhat University (TRU), a local public university in Thailand, is organizing an international English speech contest for those ASEAN universities in order to principally promote sustainable relationships, eventually leading to invaluable exchange of experiences in terms of ASEAN languages, cultures, and traditions between Thai and other ASEAN students.

#### 2. PURPOSES

- To provide students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities with an opportunity to enhance their English speaking abilities.
- 2. To promote sustainable relationships among students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities.
- To create an educational network, which is beneficial to both students and lecturers from participating universities in terms of exchange programs and other international competitions in the future.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY

Contestants whose native language is not English must be Bachelor's degree students, majoring in any fields, from Rajabhat or other ASEAN universities, including Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Singapore, Brunei, Laos, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Indonesia. No more than three contestants can be sent by one university.

#### 4. SPEECH SUBJECT

Contestants must prepare their <u>five - to seven- minute speeches</u> on
"What Aspect of Soft Power in Your Country Ought to be Promoted for International
Reputation? Why?"

#### 5. RULES OF CONTEST

- 1. Each speech will be 5-7 minutes long. A contestant will be disqualified if the speech is less than four minutes or more than eight minutes.
- 2. Contestants will deliver speeches within 5-7 minutes.
- 3. Contestants will deliver their speeches in the order determined by drawing lots, which will be announced on the bulletin board in front of the auditorium.
- 4. Each contestant must make a speech without any audio-visual aids or equipment.
- 5. Speech contest criteria
  - 5.1 Introduction: Self-introduction, Leading-in, Coherence, Ending (10 points)
  - 5.2 Content: Relatedness to the theme, Language Usage, Comprehensibility, Sequence, Conclusion (40 points)
  - 5.3 Voice Usage: Pronunciation, Accent, Cluster, Final Sound (25 points)
  - 5.4 Appearance: Body Language, Eye Contact, Personality (20 points)
  - 5.5 Time Management: Appropriateness (5 points)
- 6. The five contestants who can pass to the final round will only be asked a question and have to spend at least 1.30 minutes to answer it. (Ability to Answer Question: 20 points)

#### 6. AWARDS

- 1. The winner and his/her speech coach will be awarded 9,900 Baht (approx. 280 USD) with a certificate.
- 2. The first runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 8,000 Baht (approx. 225 USD) with a certificate.
- 3. The second runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 7,000 Baht (approx. 195 USD) with a certificate.
- 4. The third runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 6,000 Baht (approx. 170 USD) with a certificate.
- 5. The fourth runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 5,000 Baht (approx. 140 USD) with a certificate.

<sup>\*\*</sup> All contestants will receive a participation certificate, which will be available for collection on the contest day at 04:30 p.m.

## The 1st INTERNATIONAL LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PRESENTATION COMPETITION FOR RAJABHAT AND ASEAN UNIVERSITIES

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

In the light of a rapidly changing world and globalization, higher education has a central role to play in driving progress towards the UN Sustainable Development Goals. To achieve the SDGs, transformative action and collaboration are required at all levels, from local to global, and across industries and disciplines. Universities play a critical role in accomplishing the goals of sustainable development through education, research, and innovation. Consequently, this competition is organized to allow the participants to present the projects that they implemented in terms of best practices, success stories, and lessons learned. This will highlight how academic institutions, through their teaching, research, and campus administration, are facilitating transformative change towards a more equitable and sustainable world.

#### 2. OBJECTIVES

- To provide Rajabhat and other ASEAN university students the opportunity to improve their English presentation skills.
- To promote long-term relationships between Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities' students.
- 3) To establish an educational network that will benefit both students and lecturers from participating universities in future exchange programs and international competitions.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Students whose native language is not English are eligible to apply.
- 2) Applicants must be Bachelor's degree students, majoring in any academic fields, from Rajabhat or other ASEAN universities, including Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Singapore, Brunei, Laos, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Indonesia.
- 3) No more than one team may represent a university. Each team may consist of two to five members.
- 4) The <u>application deadline is 4<sup>th</sup> September</u>, but the competition entry period will end once 15 teams have applied.

#### 4. THEME OF THE PRESENTATION

The major theme of the presentation is "YOUR UNVIERSITY AND SUSTAINABILITY DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGs): BEST PRACTISES, INSPIRATIONAL STORIES, AND LESSONS LEARNED."

#### 5. RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1) The presentation order is determined by a lottery at the registration desk. Those who arrive after the competition has started will be disqualified.
- 2) Each presentation must last between 10 and 12 minutes. The point will not be deducted if the team ends their presentation 15 seconds before or after the specified period. Time violations will result in the deduction of 2 penalty points for every 15 seconds over or under the maximum.
- 3) Immediately after each presentation, the panel of judges will ask 3 questions regarding the project presentation.
- 4) Only presentation slides containing text and/or images are allowed. Additional electronic media (such as audio and video files) are NOT permitted.
- 5) The content and presentation of the team must be based on the 17 indicators of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and must NOT be copied from any sources. Any plagiarism discovered will result in disqualification.
- 6) The presentation must be delivered in English. No scripting is permitted.
- 7) The presentation room will be equipped with basic audio/visual equipment (such as a screen, projector, HDMI, VGA cable, a presentation remote, and a computer with Microsoft Office).
- 8) By 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023, the presentation file must be emailed to <monsicha.ch6@gmail.com>. Before submitting the file, any fonts other than the system fonts should be embedded.
- 9) The judging criteria are based on: introduction (5 points), content (45 points), media (25 points), delivery (20 points), and time management (5 points). The details are as follows:
